Fire


The Black Fire is at approximately 167,378 acres with 14% containment.

Smoke

Northwest winds continue today, with any increased fire activity we will see smoke impacts increase in the late afternoon into the evenings. Winston and surrounding area will see unhealthy conditions again today with periods of hazardous in the mid morning hours. Magdalena and Socorro will see average good air quality today. Increased fire activity will bring periods of Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (USG) south of the fire. Truth or Consequences will see smoke impacts late in the evening as winds from the northwest continue. Increased fire activity will produce periods of USG in the area late in the day. Low lying areas and drainages will see increased smoke. Caballo will see periods of moderate smoke throughout the evening hours. Gila Cliff Dwelling may see some periods of moderate smoke with increased fire activity on the southwest part of the fire. Hanover will see smoke increase along the Mimbres river drainage later in the afternoon.

Air Quality Index

Below is a brief explanation of the Air Quality Index (AQI). The colors indicate the average air quality for the day. Actions to take when you see the air quality change in your area. Additional links also provide information for the days air quality and what you can do to protect yourself and others. The outlook has a link associated that will give live updates if any significant changes occur.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
● Good	None
● Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
● USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
● Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
● Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
● Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
