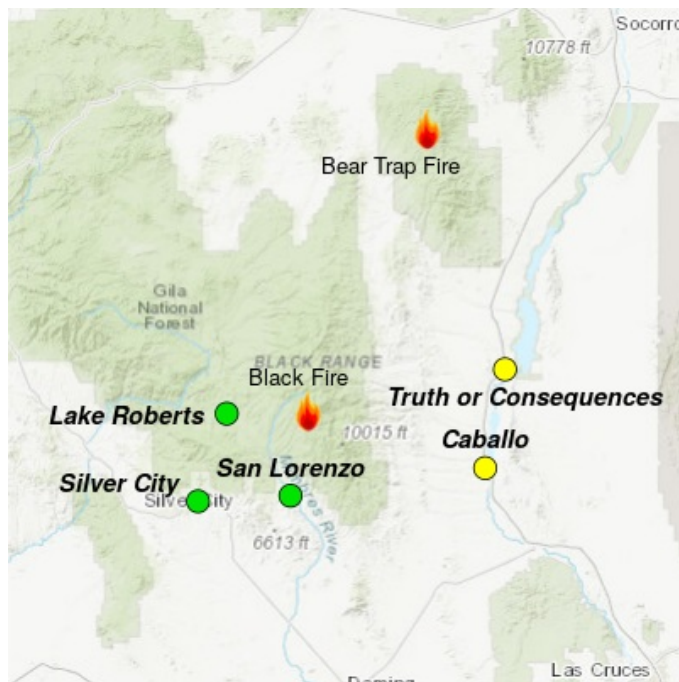

Fire

The Black Fire is at approximately 287,283 with 49% containment.

Smoke

Winds in the area will again be coming from the southwest similar to yesterday. Winston and Chloride will continue to see moderate smoke in the area. Gila Cliff Dwellings area should continue to see good air quality. Truth or Consequences and Caballo will probably have moderate air quality with periods of USG (unhealthy for sensitive people) and continued haze. Lake Roberts, Mimbres, Hanover, Kingston and San Lorenzo should have good air quality. Silver City will see good air quality today with SW winds. See below links for more information.
