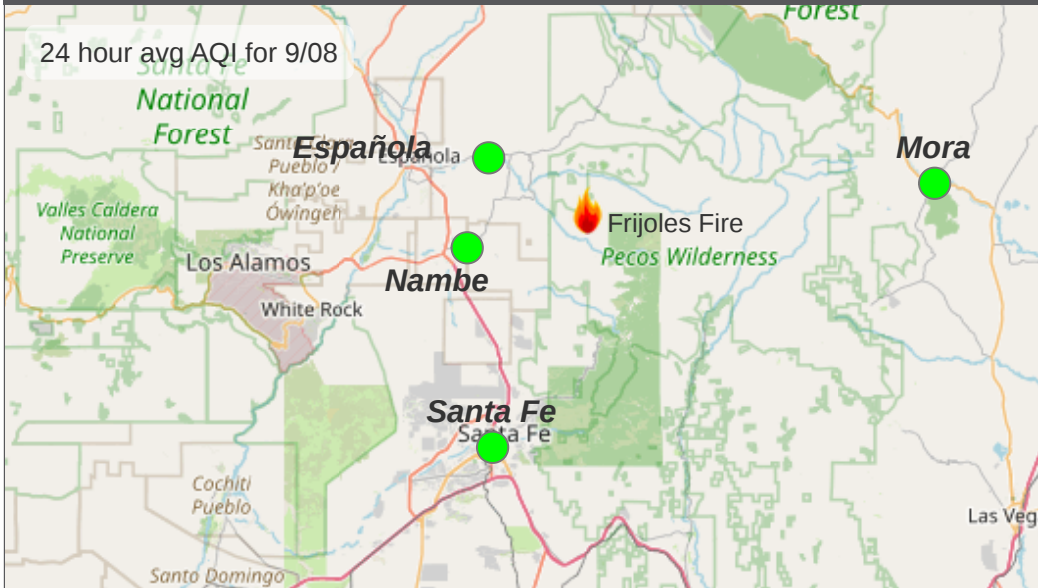
Northern New Mexico – Frijoles Fire

FIRE

The **Frijoles** fire is currently estimated at 15,483 acres and is 79% contained. Fire activity for the **Frijoles** fire is expected to remain active.

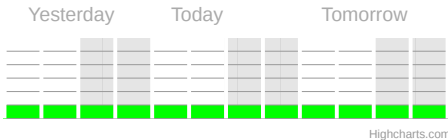
SMOKE

Smoke from the eastern flank of the fire will be noticeable again today with active surface fire behavior. Approximately 30 acres burned yesterday and can be expected again today. Mora, Nambe, Espanola and Santa Fe should all see GOOD air quality all day. The Frijoles River valley east of Chimayo may have a period of MODERATE in the evening but will have an average of GOOD for the day. Smoke may also settle east of the fire at the base of the the Sangre de Christos mountains. The highest amounts of smoke will stay be in the wilderness area and mountains to the east of the fire.

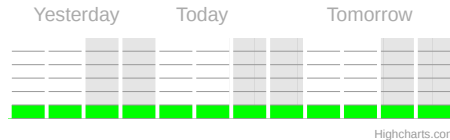
FINAL OUTLOOK

This is the final smoke outlook for this incident.

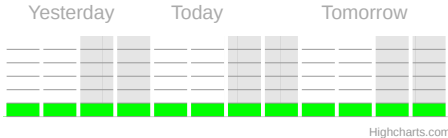
Santa Fe GOOD air quality all day.



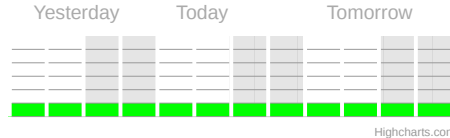
Espanola Expect GOOD air quality all day.

	Very Unhealthy (VU)	Everyone should avoid all physical outdoor activity
	Unhealthy (U)	People within Sensitive Groups should avoid all physical activity
	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (USG)	People within Sensitive Groups should reduce prolonged or heavy exertion
	Moderate (M)	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion
	Good (G)	None
